About Hope Lutheran Church

Hope Lutheran is a community of faith reaching back over 125 years in Enumclaw, WA. While we celebrate our long history of ministry in this community, we are excited for the future of the church and where God is leading us. Hope is a welcoming and inclusive community.

This position is called to care for families already involved in the church, along with other families in our community seeking a church home. We believe Hope is that home for many more individuals and families in Enumclaw and beyond!

The Vision for Family Ministry at Hope

Often ministry to children and youth begin and end with age specific ministry. The vision for Family Ministry at Hope Lutheran is for ministry to Children and Youth to be integrated into the ministry of the whole congregation. The hope is for age specific ministry (Youth Group, Children's Church, etc.) to be in coordination with what is being encouraged among the whole congregation.

Our current CYF programming includes Children's Church on Sunday morning, Sunday night Youth Group, and ongoing fellowship/service/fun multi-gen activities. We also have summer youth trips and other special events/retreats throughout the year.

Responsibilities:

- Lead regular Youth Group. (6th - 12th Grades)
- Provide opportunities for youth to serve, learn, and fellowship together.
- Coordinate retreats, summer mission trips, or camp.
- Build a team of volunteers to share in the ministry Youth
- Continue to incorporate Youth into Hope's existing ministries.
- Lead Fundraisers as needed. (i.e. Easter Breakfast, Garage Sale, etc.)
- Oversee all aspects of Youth Ministry.
- Other duties as necessary.

Expectations:

- A committed faith in Jesus Christ with a sense of call to serve Children, Youth, and Families.
- A self starter with the capability of continuing the strong Family Ministry at Hope Lutheran Church.

- Beliefs congruent with the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America and with Hope's Welcome Statement
- An excellent communicator.
- The ability to develop relationships with kids, parents, and other members of the congregation.
- A degree in Youth and Family Ministry, an equivalent degree, or equivalent experience is preferred.
- Successfully pass a background check.

Compensation:
