

Guidelines for Outdoor Gatherings at Hope Lutheran Church

Prior to Gathering

The church will:

- Clean and disinfect all high contact surfaces.
- Restock soap and paper towels necessary for hand washing.
- Ensure hand sanitizer will be available.
- Place signage and/or markings to indicate physical distancing and others guidelines.

We ask that you will:

- Determine if you are well enough to gather. As much as we would love to see, if you do not feel well, please stay home. Also, if you are a member of a vulnerable people group, please stay home until you feel safe gathering at Hope.
- Have read this document, "Guidelines for Outdoor Gatherings at Hope Lutheran Church," along with the document, "Four Guiding Principles for Reopening Hope Lutheran Church." By attending, you agree to follow these guidelines and principles.

While Gathered

- Please provide 6ft of physical distance from those not in your immediate household. Depending on where we are gathered outside, different signage and/or markings will be used to indicate physical distancing.

- Please bring and wear a face mask.
- To limit the amount of cleaning and sanitation, please bring a lawn chair from home. If you do not have one or would be more comfortable in another chair, the church will certainly provide you with a chair from Berg Hall.
- The church building will remain closed, including the use of restrooms.
- We ask that the food your bring only be shared with yourself and those in your immediate household. (aka - the selfish potluck)

After Gathering

- The church will clean and sanitize all high contact surfaces.
- Your church leadership will evaluate and learn from each gathering to implement best practices moving forward.
- If you are diagnosed with COVID-19 within 14 days of the gathering, please contact the church. That way, the church can notify other's in attendance of a possible spread. Your identity will remain anonymous unless requested otherwise.
