Worship Music Leader Job Description

The Worship Music Leader's responsibilities will include:

- The Worship Music Leader, in partnership with the pastor and other musician, will select music appropriate for the worship services, liturgical seasons, and selected Scripture readings.
- The Worship Music Leader will participate in regular Sunday worship services.
- The Worship Music Leader will facilitate regular rehearsal.
- Worship Music Leader will seek and nurture other musical gifts within the congregation to be shared during worship.
- The Worship Music Leader will make recommendations to the church council for upgrades and repairs on musical and other equipment necessary for worship.

Expectations:

- A sense of call to serve the church through music.
- The ability to effectively partner with other leaders and volunteers.
- Proficient in leading worship music.
- Beliefs congruent with the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America.
- Excellent Communicator.
- Regular meetings and collaboration with the Pastor.

Compensation:

- This is a 10 hour a week position. The Worship Music Leader's salary will range from \$10,000 - \$14,000 per year dependent upon experience.
- The Worship Music Leader will receive a minimal of four Sundays off per year. However, self care for our leaders and, if applicable, their families are important. The number of Sundays off per year can be negotiated and discussed during the hiring process.
